

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

THORN TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES SPECIAL SESSION

Held: August 8, 2018

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The Board of Trustees of Thorn Township convened in a special session from 4:30 P.M. to 4:50 P.M. in the Township Hall. David Lyle called the special meeting to order with the following members and visitors present:

Trustee Lyle stated that the purpose of the special meeting is to finalize a decision on the removal of a privacy fence erected on a right-a-way at 15369 Twp. Rd 1073.

Trustee Wilson advised that he went down to the County to get information on the division of the property if a right-a-way is closed. He was told at the Perry County Engineers Office that the property would be split half and half to the property owners on either side of the right-a-way. Mr. Bushby had stated in the last regular meeting that his deed shows that all of the property would go to him if the right-a-way was closed and Trustee Wilson wanted clarification on this from the county. Trustee Wilson informed Mr. Bushby that he was told at the Engineers Office that the surveyors had made a mistake and that his deed was incorrect. Further discussion was held.
